Renaissance College follows the International Baccalaureate seven point grading scale.

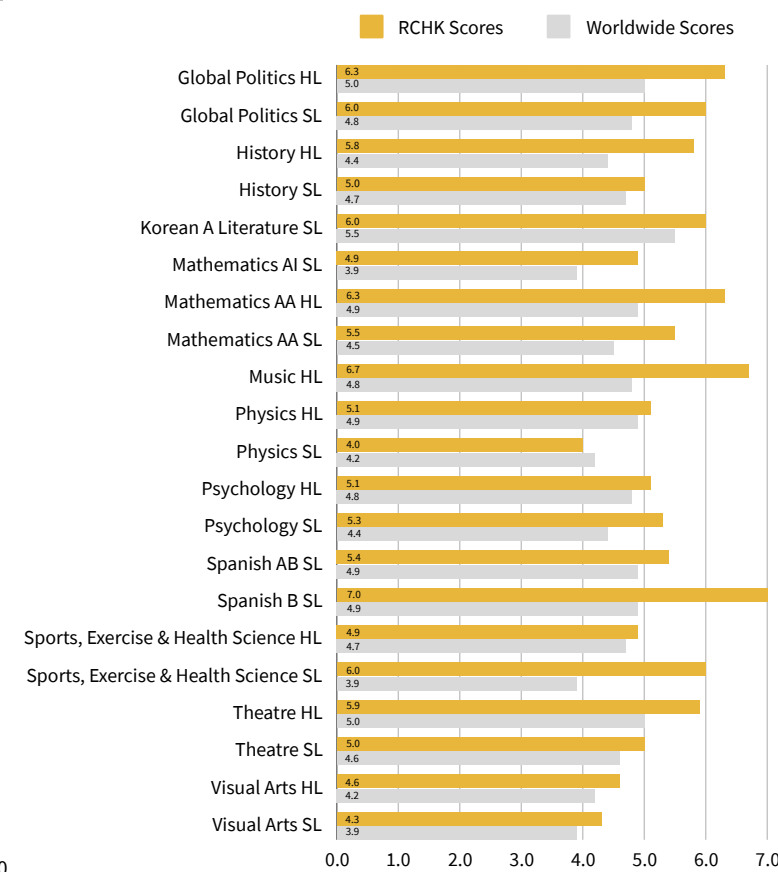
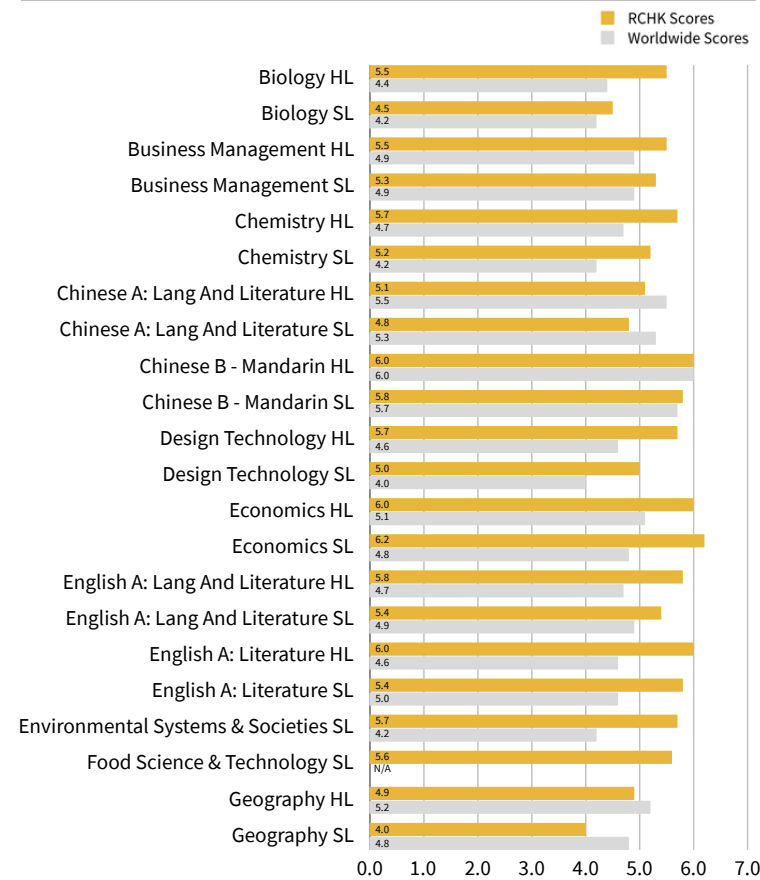

RCHK offers the Primary Years Programme (PYP), the Middle Years Programme (MYP), the Diploma Programme (DP) and the Career-Related Programme (IBCP). Year 12 and 13 students take the full IB Diploma Programme, IB Courses or IBCP. Students are not ranked at RCHK. Formal student assessment is criterion-based. Students receive two full semester reports and one progress report each academic year.

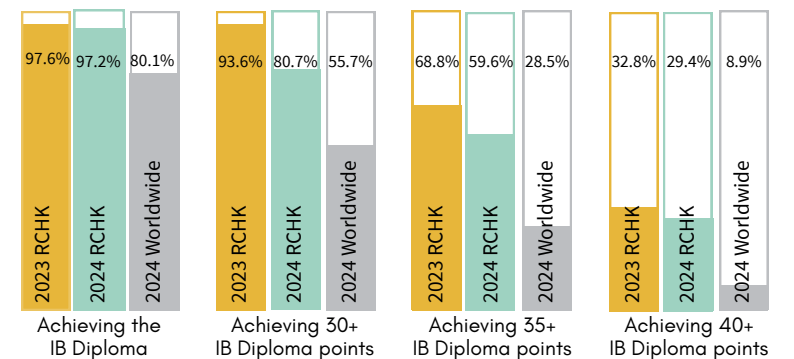
Students are required to study the following MYP subjects from Years 7 to 11. Additionally, students participate in Service as Action.
